## **Deepak Obhrai joins Ottawa's Indo-Canadian community on National Day of Remembrance to remember victims of the Air India tragedy**

(Ottawa) On Thursday, June 23, 2011, Deepak Obhrai, M.P. and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Foreign Affairs, attended a memorial service at the Air India Memorial at Dows Lake in Ottawa, in remembrance of the victims of the Air India Flight 182 atrocity, which occurred 26 years ago today.

On June 23, 1985, Canadians experienced the worst terrorist attack in Canada's history when a bomb on Air India Flight 182 killed all 329 passengers and crew members aboard, most of them Indo-Canadians.

We must ensure that the victims of this worst terrorist attack in our history are not forgotten and that we do not forget the pain and loss experienced by the victims' loved ones, Obhrai said.
