Deepak was recently named as one of the “25 Most Influential Indians In North America,” by reputed Indian publishing house, Global Indian Origin, that researches and publishes on the Indian diaspora.

Their latest magazine titled “25 Most Influential Indians In North America,” features Deepak as a brilliant and hard-working Indo-Canadian politician, who broke the glass ceiling of racial barriers to achieve great heights in Canadian politics.
