Parliamentary Secretary Deepak Obhrai represents Canada at the Pacific Islands Forum, reinforces ties with South Korea, and advances Canadian interests in India.

(Calgary) August 27th, 2012. As part of the strategic focus on the pacific region, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Deepak Obhrai, M.P. will represent Canada at the Pacific Islands Forum where he will engage in dialogue on priority areas with pacific nations and meet with New Zealand's Foreign Minister to discuss areas of common interests.

From the Pacific Islands Forum, Mr. Obhrai will travel to South Korea to reinforce the strong ties between Canada and South Korea, and to show our mutual respect by laying a wreath at the War Memorial of Korea.

The Parliamentary Secretary will then be in India to advance Canada-India relations and meet with his counterparts. As a sign of the growing relationship between our two countries, Mr. Obhrai will attend the official opening of the new offices of the Consulate General of Canada in Mumbai. He will also spend some time listening to Canadian and Indian business people to hear from industry their thoughts on how to improve our economic ties.
